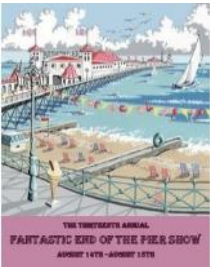

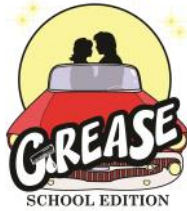

Sir John Mason FRSA is principle lecturer at the South Downs Planetarium in Chichester.
