1	Footpath	Commencing at Shore Road, East Wittering and running in a westerly direction along the foreshore around East Head and thence via Ella Nore in a northerly direction via Chalkdock Point, West Itchenor, and the Customs House to Itchenor Road at the foreshore, continuing to low water mark.
1/1	Footpath	A link between footpath no. 1 in the Parish of West Wittering, extending north-eastwards between grid references 76559839 and 76599844.
2	Footpath	From the highway south of the Rectory at Earnley in a southerly direction and thence in a westerly direction to Farm Road at Bracklesham Bay.
3	Footpath	From the East Wittering-Shipton Green Road in an easterly direction passing Church Farm, Stubcroft Farm and Clayton's Farm, crossing Bracklesham Lane to the Birdham- Earnley Road.
4	Footpath	From East Bracklesham Drive northwards to path 2 at the East Wittering-Earnley Parish Boundary.
5	Footpath	From Church Farm in the Parish of East Wittering in a north-westerly direction via Hale Farm to the highway near Piggery Hall, in the Parish of West Wittering.

24	Footpath	A short length of footpath running from path 23 via the Vicarage to the road at the Church, West Wittering.
25	Footpath	From the highway north of the school West Wittering in a westerly direction to path number 1 at the foreshore immediately north of Snow Hill, thence south and east to the highway north of the Church.
